Lions Quest Annual Symposium:

Lions Quest has been a permanent activity of Lions Club of North Bombay since last 22 years. The club is implementing Lions Quest in 41 school in Mumbai, Bhiwandi and Pune with 6168 students for the year 2018-19. To keep teachers updated, each year we organise refresher workshops for teachers.

For the past 10 years the club, with the initiative and dedicated involvement of Our Club Chairman and guide PDG Lion Shafi Thanawala have been doing extensive work with Anjuman-I-Islam group of schools in Mumbai & Pune. 17 secondary schools are implementing Lions Quest Skills for Adolescence program and 14 primary schools are implementing Skills for Growing program.

To meet and discuss the yearly reports from the school for Lions Quest implementation along with honoring the teachers and students who complete the SFA & SFG course, the club organises LIONS QUEST ANNUAL SYMPOSIUM since last 7 years.

This year the 7th Annual symposium was held on 5th January 2019 at Saboo Siddiki College of Engineering, Byculla, Mumbai and was attended by 800 plus students, teachers, principals and parents. To get the best output each year we keep competitions based on Lions Quest theme, and the schools participate very enthusiastically. All the school send their innovative yearly reports which shows the different activities done in school based on Lions Quest and the feedback of students, teachers and parents. All these reports are collectively shared by us in this symposium.

Though they send their reports, but they themselves presented their reports at the Symposium. Best presentation reports were awarded Excellence Awards in SFA and SFG Through the talk show we all could assess the innumerable benefits through Lions Quest on the lives of these families.



Price Reduction of Skills for Growing books

We are please to inform that, to have maximum implementation of Lions Quest SFG program, the rates of SFG books are being reduced from 17th February 2019 as follows.

(Teacher set Present rate 950/-) (Student Set Present Rate 100/-)

Rates Reduced to Teacher Sets 600/-Student Sets 60/-

These rates will be uniformly applicable to all Multiples under LQIF.

We are also happy to announce that SFG will have same criteria of Reimbursement as SFA from 17th February 2019. That means any workshop conducted purely for SFG will be eligible for reimbursement as per Reimbursement Criteria set earlier for SFA & SFA/SFG Combined workshop.

I hope that we all together will expand the horizon of implementation of SFG program in this Lions Year.

Program overview:


Ariel Dickson had presented and conducted the program on behalf of LCIF and this was the first ever South Asia meeting for Lions Quest of its kind. India [with two foundations – Lions Quest in India Foundation – {LQIF} and South India Lions Quest Foundation {SILQF}], Sri Lanka, Bangladesh & Nepal participated in the Meeting.


Leaders from LQIF and SILQF of Country India presented their report with relevant data and also shared their experiences about Lions Quest. Recently, LCIF had done a project on Lions Quest with Bangladesh which was explained and briefed by representatives from Bangladesh. Sri Lanka is also slowly developing Lions Quest, initially through Government tie ups as told by their representatives. Nepal is going to start Lions Quest shortly in their region with help of new Grant application followed by sanction of Grant from LCIF.

Program Conclusion and Resolutions:

LCIF is planning to organise South Asia Regional meeting every year from now on. Next year, the meeting will be held at Bangalore at a suitable time, mostly in December 2019 or February 2010.

Few important point and resolutions were formed at the end of two day meeting and all have agreed to work towards overcoming or implementing that in coming year. The same will be reviewed and discussed in the next meeting with the outcome/result after implementation.
